The Foundation Team reviewed the 2009-10 survey data and found that respect is an issue in the hallways and on the school buses. Students identified the following four problem areas: being polite and respectful, drug or alcohol abuse, and feeling safe on the bus. Staff identified drug and alcohol use, students feeling safe on the bus, and bullying. Parents identified drug and alcohol abuse, bullying and kids being polite and respectful. The concerns raised by the CJMS Spring Climate Survey are supported by the 2009-10 discipline data.
