PROGRESS SUMMARY

At the end of the school year, Irving adopted the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program and implemented its survey to grades 3 - 5. Since the Foundations survey from 2011 is different from the 2012 Olweus survey, we were unable to compare responses. Irving Elementary will compare the data from the Olweus survey in 2012 with the future surveys to look for an increase in positive responses and to continue to work on any identified concerns.

Irving will adopt the Olweus model in the fall of 2012 and train all staff members in order to promote a positive school climate. Irving staff members will also have the option to adopt the Bucketfiller model to help assist in promoting positive behavior.

Irving will also continue Irving RULES, Steps to Respect, Second Step, and the DARE program to promote a positive climate. Irving will also continue to celebrate the diversity in our school through programs such as International Days and the American Indian Pow Wow Club.
