In a year, we hope to see the following progress on this strategic objective:

Our first goal is to see improvement in every student as measured by an average gain of 5% on his or her Math CRT score. A second goal is to have 84% of CJMS students proficient as measured on the Math CRT.

PROGRESS SUMMARY

- 1. We examined our previous year's math LRSP at our Fall staff meeting; providing the connection with our district Goals and our scores on the 2010 Math CRT.
- 2. Math CRT scores shared with the 2010-2011 Math Teachers.
- 3. All students identified as Novice and Nearing Proficient on the 2010 Math CRT, were placed in the appropriate math class based on their math needs support through Cluster math classes.
- 4. Math Intervention Teachers structured Math Intervention classes and placed identified students to best meet the needs of CJMS at-risk students.
- 5. Core math teachers and math intervention teacher met and communicated, during monthly Professional Learning Community (PLC) meetings.
- 6. Faculty meetings were devoted to continued RtI training all teachers.
- 7. Had hoped to use administrative team meetings to discuss and monitor progress of N and NP students. This action step was not met and will be added to next year's 1.02 CJMS P+ Math Stategic Objective.
- 8. 2010-11 CRT math scores were shared with staff the last week of school and will be used to write our math objective for the 2011-12 school year.
