#### **PROGRESS SUMMARY**

Throughout the year, emphasis continued to be placed on the improvement of student writing within the Communication Arts classrooms and Curriculum Leadership Team. The writing assessment data is continuing to be evaluated to determine specific growth of our students based on the district assessments. Students were placed into cluster classes during the school year based on identified abilities. Students within these classes were instructed and provided learning opportunities based their academic abilities. Additionally, enrichment opportunities were also provided through elective and Access classes. An on-going consideration will be opportunities for students needing additional support either within communication arts classes or as supplementry classes (e.g. Access classes).

Teachers of writing worked collaboratively throughout the year both at the school and district level. Although a Professional Learning Community did not exist specific to writing, teachers shared instructional ideas, reviewed standards, and discussed assessments through in-school teams and the district CLT. Preliminary focus on the new Common Core Standards and the impact on the writing curriculum was initiated and will continue throughout the coming year.
