In a year, we hope to see the following progress on this strategic objective:

Expansion of GATE classes at BHS.

Continuation/expansion of PEAKS cluster pilot.

PROGRESS SUMMARY

- •Gather data on cluster 2008-09 cluster pilot and develop formalized evaluation plan (that includes attitudinal and growth data for all stakeholders) and compile and analyze 2008-09 and 2009-10 cluster pilot data to determine success. In progress. We now have an MSU graduate student who is initiating a longitudinal study.
- •Continue cluster pilot in elementary schools. Continuing. ED, IRV, and HY are presently participating and MOST will be added next year at 4th and 5th grade.
- •PEAKS students will be clustered in CA and Math Classes at Middle Schools. Completed and will continue in 2011-12.
- •GATE classes will be offered in English, Science, Social Studies and Math in grades 9 & 10 at BHS. Implemented at grade 9 in English, Science, and Social Studies.
- •Professional development related to gifted issues/differentiation will be offered to all teachers including AGATE, Flex, evening workshops, and via instructional coaches, and on-going differentiation training for cluster teachers, as well as training specific for instructional coaches.
- Completed and will be on-going.
- •Increase PEAKS staff; One elementary coordinator in conjunction with instructional coaches; one high school coordinator, release time for one teacher (one course) per middle school. Due to budgetary constraints, this was not able to be accomplished.
- •Independent study/projects to be offered 9-12. On-going.
- •Procurement and implementation of advanced DRP. DRP will no longer be used. The District will be transitioning to a different assessment.
- •Expand MSU connections for gifted mentors. MSU connections have been expanded. Our gifted mentors have increased.
- •Maintain parent group and include a parent from each level (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) on Gifted Steering Committee. On-going. We plan to add a Community/MSU committee as well.

- •Infuse gifted information in Professional Learning Community (PLC) dialogues and in Response to Instruction/Intervention committees and processes. On-going. We will continue to work to embed gifted information in to RtI and PLC discussions and content area work.
- •Professional development for K-12 counselors; continued dialogue about counselor model and how to best serve needs of gifted students. Professional development was provided to counselors. Each year, they have the opportunity to attend AGATE. Need to find out from Rob. Marilyn will request a PEAKS/GT icon.
- •Coordinate with MSU to develop pre-service teacher training in gifted education. In process.
