#### **In a year, we hope to see the following progress on this strategic objective:**

Hawthorne's Instructional Coach will collaborate with all grade levels and across all content areas, continue strong teacher/coach relationships, model, and provide support in all academic areas.

#### **PROGRESS SUMMARY**

Instructional coaching at Hawthorne is in its 3rd year and continues its growth. The coach worked with 100% (14/14) of classroom teachers in some capacity of professional development (from individual to group), 67% (4/6) Specialists/Resource Teachers and Interventionists, and 50% (2/4) Paraprofessionals. All interactions were voluntary, non-evaluative, and confidential.

Instructional coaching has assisted in a range of professional development at Hawthorne in the school year 2010-2011, including:

1. developing Writer's Workshop for all classroom teachers
2. differentiating 'walk-to' models for math and reading
3. differentiated workshop approaches to reading (literature circles & book groups)
4. continued integration of technology into existing curriculum
5. modeling, planning, and resource discovery with the new social studies curriculum
6. continued implementation of the science curriculum
7. facilitated five teachers visit and observe master teachers across the district
