Hawthorne's Instructional Coach will collaborate with all grade levels and across all content areas, continue strong teacher/coach relationships, model, and provide support in all academic areas.

#### **PROGRESS SUMMARY**

Instructional coaching at Hawthorne is in its 3rd year and continues its growth. The coach worked with 100% (14/14) of classroom teachers in some capacity of professional development (from individual to group), 67% (4/6) Specialists/Resource Teachers and Interventionists, and 50% (2/4) Paraprofessionals. All interactions were voluntary, non-evaluative, and confidential.

Instructional coaching has assisted in a range of professional development at Hawthorne in the school year 2010-2011, including:

- 1. developing Writer's Workshop for all classroom teachers
- 2. differentiating 'walk-to' models for math and reading
- 3. differentiated workshop approaches to reading (literature circles & book groups)
- 4. continued integration of technology into existing curriculum
- 5. modeling, planning, and resource discovery with the new social studies curriculum
- 6. continued implementation of the science curriculum
- 7. facilitated five teachers visit and observe master teachers across the district
