#### **In a year, we hope to see the following progress on this strategic objective:**

100% of our classroom teachers will use our instructional coach in some sort of collaborative capacity (ex. finding new resources for our new Social Studies Curriculum, increasing technology within the classroom, model lessons, planning lessons based on curriculum standards and best practices. At least 50% of our classified staff will use the instructional coach's services. Have a consistent meeting time between the instructional coach and the principal to discuss the needs of Irving school.

#### **PROGRESS SUMMARY**

During the 2010 - 2011 school year, 100% of our classroom teachers used our instructional coach but not necessarily in our definition of quality coaching. Everybody has asked for assistance, but not everyone used our coach in a professional development way. 60% of our classified staff used our instructional coach in a collaborative working model.

Under our definition of quality coaching (collaboratively working with our instructional coach in a form of professional development) we have the following data:

11 of our 13 (84.6%) classroom teachers collaborated with our Instructional Coach.

4 of our 9 (44.4%) certified non-classroom staff collaborated with our Instructional Coach.

3 of our 5 (60%) classified staff members collaborated with our Instructional Coach.

With the new format of professional development occurring next school year, I plan on having our instructional coach assist our classroom and specialist teachers in this process. Our instructional coach will also be an integral member in implementing an RtI system in all six grade levels next year. We will continue with our goal of providing quality coaching to all staff members at Irving School.
