PROGRESS SUMMARY

Goals 1 & 4. Staff awareness of RtI principles and the implications for all academic and behavioral areas continues to expand within the staff. Staff is committed to providing appropriate supports for all students at all levels. Monitoring of student progress on formative and summative assessments guides instructional decisions more frequently and precisely. Goal 2. School RtI team meet monthly throughout the year. Team focused on developing Pathways for reading screening and interventions. This work will continue next year. Goal 3. Team participated in the OPI RtI training throughout the year. Training guided the work of the school wide RtI team. Longfellow has applied for continuing OPI support and training during the 2011-12 school year.
