PROGRESS SUMMARY

During the 2010 - 2011 school year, 100% of our classroom teachers used the mobile lab and/or multimedia cart to assist in the technology proficiency of Irving's students. Classroom teachers' tech use ranged from using digital presenters and projectors to model writing lessons; to classrooms using mobile labs for Internet research and creating powerpoints to share out information; to web-based typing lessons; to Safari Montage videos; to morning calendar via a SMARTBoard in a Kindergarten classroom. With the assistance of our tech mentor and instructional coach, mobile labs and multimedia carts are being used more frequently, and Irving plans on purchasing three more carts in order to meet the needs of the teachers (increasing our total to 10). We plan to continue to increase the use of technology in the classroom by providing training throughout the year for our staff members.
