In a year, we hope to see the following progress on this strategic objective:

1. Common understanding among staff, regarding the RtI plan as it relates to social/behavioral goals and interventions.
2. Continuing focus on increasing the level of respectful behavior among students in the common areas of the school, specifically on the playgrounds during recess blocks.
3. Expand the use of the “Words of Wisdom” material to include student discussions in multiple settings (classroom, lunch room, CARES).

PROGRESS SUMMARY

1. Formal and informal discussions have provided a common understanding among staff that LO has students who are behaviorally at benchmark, while others have strategic and intensive needs in this area. School-wide RtI team is looking to play and expanded role in review behavioral needs at the strategic and intensive levels. RtI team will work more closely with the Foundations Committee to develop strategies and protocols.
2. School-wide training in issues surrounding the "Bullying" issues was accomplished. ALL staff members were trained by Laura St. John in some of the latest research and best practices for working with bullies. Foundations team will be working to implement a school-wide intervention plan in 2011-12.
3. This goal was not accomplished due to a refocusing on other common area expectations and development of a scope and sequence for implementation of the guidance curriculum. foundations team will reexamine this resource to see how it will best fit into the bigger picture of school-wide consistencies.
